**Rocky Mountain House is the first municipality in Alberta to implement this program, which allows residential property owners to finance up to 100% of their energy efficiency or renewable energy projects.**

The Clean Energy Improvement Program, or CEIP, is an innovative financing tool for residential property owners to finance up to 100% of energy efficiency upgrades and renewable energy installations. CEIP offers competitive financing and makes repayment convenient through your property's regular tax bill.

**HIGHLIGHTS** This program provides an affordable way for homeowners to make energy-saving improvements to their homes through low interest financing. Plus, the program creates opportunities for local contractors.

**PARTICIPANT & PROPERTY ELIGIBILITY** Must be the legal owner of an existing low-rise residential property located in the Town of Rocky Mountain House and meet all requirements listed in the Town of Rocky Mountain House Program Terms and Conditions.

**ELIGIBLE UPGRADES** All eligible energy efficiency and renewable energy upgrades are posted at [myCEIP.ca/residential](http://myCEIP.ca/residential). Upgrades must have a minimum cost of \$3,000 to qualify for financing.

# PROPERTY TAXES ARE DUE

A 10% penalty will be applied on any outstanding property tax balance, including any utilities that were transferred to taxes due to non-payment.
