TOWN OF ROCKY MOUNTAIN HOUSE REACTS TO NOVA GAS EXPANSION APPROVAL

Rocky Mountain House, Alta. – The Town of Rocky Mountain House is pleased to learn of the Government of Canada's final approval of the NOVA Gas Transmission Ltd. (NGTL) 2021 System Expansion Project, announced this week.

"This is really welcome news for our community," said Town of Rocky Mountain House Mayor Tammy Burke. "This is the economic boon our region needs at this time."

This project will have an immediate positive effect on the area economy, with construction on the project segments near Rocky Mountain House to begin as soon as early December.

"We have a very qualified service industry in our community," said Mayor Burke. "TC Energy has indicated they will be looking to local contractors to meet some of its workforce demand, and it is our hope that local businesses are able to benefit from this important project."
