

## Highlights from the May 11, 2021 Regular Council meetings

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### 2021 Tax Rate Bylaw

In accordance with the Municipal Government Act, the Town of Rocky Mountain House is required to pass an annual tax rate bylaw to levy sufficient taxes for its operation. Tax Rate Bylaw 2021/06, adopted on May 11, provides for a levy of \$9,188,996 for municipal purposes. This represents a nominal \$1,031 less than 2020, and marks the third year in a row that the Town of Rocky Mountain House had not increased its municipal taxation levy. Individual property tax bills may see slight fluctuations based on assessed value, but overall will remain comparable to last year.
