### Special Council Meeting

Pursuant to Section 194(3) of the *Municipal Government Act*, Mayor Burke called a Special Council Meeting for the purpose of discussing provincial COVID restrictions.

The Government of Alberta declared a State of Public Health Emergency on Nov. 24, 2020. Province-wide restrictions are now in place on social gatherings, festivals and events. Further restrictions will take effect on Nov. 27.

Council directed administration to assess how these restrictions will affect Town facilities and services and consider ways to offer recreation opportunities to citizens that also comply with public health orders.

Council will consider options and financial obligations at its regular scheduled council meeting on Dec. 1.

Council also asked administration to work with regional municipal and first nation partners on a public education campaign encouraging adherence to public health recommendations and orders,
