Accurate Assessment Group Ltd. will be at the Town Office on Thursday, April 17, from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM, to meet with property-owners who have questions or concerns about their assessments.

Interested property-owners may phone the Town Office to schedule an appointment, at 403-845-2866. Walk-in appointments will be accommodated where possible, but we encourage you to book ahead.

It is important that you address any concerns about your property's assessed value before the April 30, 2025 appeal deadline.
