Following a Non-statutory public hearing on March 10, Council rescinded the March 4, 1997 resolution regarding Video Lottery Terminals (VLTs), and directed administration to advise the Provincial Government and the Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission that the Town has met the legislative requirements to permit VLTs in Rocky Mountain House.
