What is CEIP?

The Clean Energy Improvement Program (CEIP), makes energy efficiency upgrades more accessible for homeowners—so you can save on energy bills and enjoy a more comfortable, efficient home for you and your family.

CEIP offers flexible financing to help cover the upfront costs of energy efficiency and renewable energy upgrades, allowing homeowners to make improvements without the big upfront investment.

Rocky Mountain House was the first municipality in Alberta to offer CEIP financing to residents when the program launched in 2021.

It provides Town of Rocky Mountain House property owners access to low-cost financing for energy efficient and renewable energy (e.g. solar PV) renovations to their homes.

CEIP offers a flexible, affordable way to offset the impact of rising energy costs while also improving your home's comfort and value. And because CEIP is a municipal government program, there are several advantages compared to conventional financing:

- **Low interest rates:** Because the program is supported by the Government of Canada, CEIP offers below-market interest rates (3.5% or less*).
- **Incentives:** Rocky Mountain House residents can apply for up to \$1,200 in incentives.
- **Long repayment terms:** Upgrades can be amortized for the effective useful life of the upgrade, up to 20 years. Longer repayment terms mean lower annual payments.
- **Property tied:** CEIP re-payments are made via regular property tax installments and CEIP re-payments can be transferred to new owners if you sell your property.

If you've already been considering some upgrades around the house, now is the time to act! **The deadline to apply for pre-qualification is January 31, 2026.**
