Regional Governance Study consultant selected

The Regional Steering Committee has selected [Nichols Applied Management](#) to conduct the Regional Governance Study. The committee, made up of representatives from Town, Clearwater County and the Village of Caroline, will oversee the consultant-led study into intermunicipal and regional governance options for the area.

Delegation: Rocky Mountain House Public Library

Council welcomed a delegation from the Rocky Mountain House Public Library, who provided an update on the library's programming successes and challenges during the COVID-19 pandemic. Library manager Ben Worth and Board Chair Robin Begin also presented the library's proposed 2021 budget, with a zero per cent increase over 2020. Council accepted the report as information and approved the 2021 budget request.
