POLICY STATEMENT

To establish a written policy, approved by Council, to outline the procedure for requesting cash-in-lieu for required onsite parking stalls as per the Land Use Bylaw.

ADMINISTRATION PROCEDURE

- 1. The Municipal Planning Commission's policy, is not to relax any required on site parking under the Land Use Bylaw. Therefore required parking stalls shall be:
 - a) provided on site,
 - b) within requirements as set out in the Land Use Bylaw walking distance provided that a restrictive covenant, ensuring the use of the property for the required number of parking spaces is registered against the title, or
 - c) a fee of \$6,000.00 shall be paid by the owners of the property which is not supplying the required parking stalls.
- 2. Any cash-in-lieu payment will be a one time only payment unless the use is altered to require a greater parking ratio under the Land Use Bylaw.
- 3. When Development Permit applications are being processed the Development Officer and or the Municipal Planning Commission shall deal with the property owner and not the applicant.
