The Town of Rocky Mountain House and Clearwater County are teaming up to better understand current and future housing needs across the region. The Town is undertaking a comprehensive Housing Needs Assessment covering residents of all ages and household types, while the County is focusing on a Seniors Housing Needs Assessment, recognizing that many County seniors rely on Rocky Mountain House for housing, healthcare, and essential services.

Like many communities across Alberta, our region is facing growing housing pressures from population growth, changing demographics, and an aging population. Together, these studies will help identify challenges, opportunities, and priorities so that residents have access to safe and affordable housing, now and into the future. The findings will help guide planning decisions, attract investment, and strengthen future grant applications.

RESIDENTIAL RECYCLING IN ROCKY MOUNTAIN HOUSE

The Town of Rocky Mountain House recycling program will soon be managed by Circular Materials, a not-for-profit organization that is committed to advancing an efficient and effective recycling system across Alberta. As of mid-July, 2026, Circular Materials will begin direct Resident Promotion and Education.

Residents will receive promotion and education information about the recycling system changes coming into effect this fall. Notably, there will be a province-wide harmonized list of accepted materials for recycling, that will include even more items than we currently accept in your blue curbside carts!

As of October 1, 2026, Circular Materials' curbside collection service begins.

There should be no change to your regular curbside collection, except for the addition of certain accepted materials.
