Rocky Mountain House, Alta. – The Town of Rocky Mountain House has accepted the resignation of Merrin Fraser from her position of Councillor, effective August 16, 2022.

The Town of Rocky Mountain House thanks Ms. Fraser for her dedicated service to the community over the past 5 years. Ms. Fraser was first elected to Council in the 2017 General Municipal Election, and returned to Council in the 2021 General Municipal Election.

The Town of Rocky Mountain House Council and Administration wish Ms. Fraser all the best in her future endeavours.

The [Municipal Government Act](#) section 165 requires municipalities to hold a byelection within 120 days of an elected official position becoming vacant. Council will set a date for the byelection to fill Ms. Fraser's seat at its next regular meeting.
