

**TOWN OF ROCKY MOUNTAIN HOUSE
BYLAW NO. 2025/12
REPEAL BYLAW**

BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF ROCKY MOUNTAIN HOUSE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, BEING CHAPTER M-26 OF THE REVISED STATUTES OF ALBERTA 2000 AND AMENDMENTS THERETO.

WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act, Section 191 states a council of a municipality may, by bylaw, repeal a bylaw subject to same consents or conditions or advertising requirements that apply to the original bylaw;

WHEREAS Council consulted with stakeholders and the public on off-site levies in accordance with Section 648.3 of the Municipal Government Act on June 11, 2025;

WHEREAS Council has determined that off-site levies be eliminated to promote economic growth for the benefit of the entire community;

AND WHEREAS Council has therefore deemed Bylaw #17/04 OS unnecessary;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Rocky Mountain House, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled enacts that the following bylaw is repealed.

1. REPEAL

1.1. That Bylaw #17/04 OS, and all amendments thereto, is hereby repealed.

2. EFFECTIVE DATE

2.1. This Bylaw comes into force upon as effect on the date of third and final reading.

READ a first time this 15th Day of July, 2025.

READ a second time this 15th Day of July, 2025.

UNANIMOUS CONSENT for third reading this 15th Day of July, 2025.

READ a third and final time this 15th Day of July, 2025.
